Writing poetry is an essential skill that assists in the crafting of any narrative form. Through careful and purposeful linguistic choices, coupled with apt literary and sound devices, understanding poetic expression will elevate our writing skills. In this workshop, we will use the emulation method to analyse poetic techniques and attempt to write our own material on top of these set forms (all creation is a form of re-creation). At the end of the workshop, you will have at least 4 poems ready for their final polish and possible publication.

Dr Ginna Brock is a lecturer in English Literature and Creative Writing at the University of the Sunshine Coast, Australia. She publishes both

creative works and critical articles. Her work investigates the concept of belonging and the ramifications of connectedness on an individual's psyche. Ginna is an editor for the Social Alternatives journal and a member of the AAWP.
