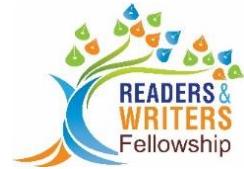
Topic: 'A Line in the Sand'

Submission Guidelines:

1. The author's name must not appear within the submitted work in any form.
 - a. Title as shown on entry form must appear in the header of each page
 - b. Page numbers must appear on the footer of each page
2. Entry form with title, your name, address, phone number and email address must be a separate page of your submission. Convenor keeps this as record of submission.
3. Each entry to be submitted typed as Word file only, not exceeding specified word count (2,000 words), in 12 Pt Courier or Times New Roman double spaced; all margins 2.54cm. (default Word file)
4. Any entry not fulfilling these conditions, handwritten, pdf file, or exceeding stated length in any category will NOT be considered for judging.
5. Results will be announced at FAWQ General meeting 21st October 2023 and published in SCOPE Magazine and on the FAWQ Website.
6. The short list of ten selected by the judge will be contacted to discuss publication in SCOPE 2024.

Conditions of Entry:

1. Entries open to all writers. Must be the original unpublished work of the entrant, not on offer for publication before the announcement of the competition and have not previously won a prize in any other competition before the award ceremony of this competition (21st October 2023).
2. No more than three entries per author.
3. Entries may be submitted online at the time of payment at <https://fawq.com.au/competitions/> OR as a Word file attachment by email to competitions@fawq.com.au with your full name, and payment code written in the body of the email.
4. Entry form with title, your name, address, phone number and email address must be a separate page on submission.
5. Copyright remains with the author.
6. The judge's decision is final. No correspondence will be entered into.
